### PREPARATIONS

#### Digital Audio Out

**TIP**

- You can also make use of the COAXIAL jack for digital audio output.

#### GENERAL EXPLANATION

**About this manual**

This manual gives the basic instructions for operating this DVD player. Some DVD discs however are produced in a way that requires specific operation or allows only limited operation during playback. In these cases the player may not respond to all operation commands. When this occurs, please refer to the instructions in the disc itself. When a "C" appears at the top of the screen, the operation is not permitted by the player or the disc.

#### Remote control operation

- Unless otherwise stated, all operations can be carried out with the remote control. Always point the remote control directly at the player, making sure there are no obstructions in the path of the infrared beam. When there are corresponding keys on the main unit, they can also be used.

#### Menu navigation

- Your player has an intuitive menu/navigation system to guide you through various settings and operations.
- Use the function keys to activate/disable relevant operations.
- Press **RETURN** to browse through menus.
- Press **STOP** to stop the operation.

Press **STOP** repeatedly for the following slow play options:

### English FUNCTIONAL OVERVIEW

#### Main unit controls (see figure 1)

- OPEN** - Open disc door to insert or remove disc
- POWER** - Switch the player on / off
- STOP** - Press once to stop playback and store the stop position
- PAUSE** - Press twice to stop playback
- PH** - Press to play/pause playback
- SEARCH** - Search backward / or search forward
- VDU** - Display menu
- SETUP** - Enter the SETUP menu
- REPEAT** - Display MENU page
- STOP** - Press once to stop playback and store the stop position
- UP / DOWN / LEFT / RIGHT** - Up / down / left / right cursor
- CONFIRM** - Confirm selection

#### Front of player (see figure 1)

- POWER/CHRR** - Power and charging indicator / Remote sensor
- PHONE** - Headphones jack
- AV OUT** - Audio/Video output jack
- AV IN** - Audio/Video input jack
- COAXIAL** - Digital audio output jack
- DC IN TVZ** - Power supply socket

### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### Hearing safe

Listening at a moderate volume:

- Using headphones at a volume level can impair your hearing. This product can produce sounds in decibel ranges that may cause hearing loss for a normal person, even for exposure less than a minute. The higher decibel ranges are not intended for use with children who have already experienced some hearing loss.
- Sound can be deceiving. Over your hearing "comfort level" adapts to low volumes of sound. So after prolonged listening, what sounds "normal" can actually be loud and harmful to your hearing. To guard against this, set your volume to a safe level before your hearing adapts and leave it there.

To establish a safe volume level:

### BASIC FUNCTIONS

#### Switching on the OSD language setup

The OSD is the default language of your player on screen display. You may use English, French, Spanish, German, Simplified Chinese or Traditional Chinese for your player's on screen display.

#### Remote control operation

- Slide the **POWER** switch to **ON** to switch on the player.
- Press **STOP** to set up menu.
- Press **GENERAL SETUP** and press **OK**.
- Scroll and select **OSD LANG** and press **STOP** to switch on OSD language options.
- Select your preferred language and press **OK**.

#### Loading discs and switching on

- Press **OPEN** to open the disc door.
- Insert your chosen disc. Label side up (also when a double sided DVD disc is inserted). Make sure it is sitting properly in the correct recess.
- Gently push to close the door.
- Slide the **POWER** switch to **ON** to switch on the player.

**TIP**

A normal mechanical noise is heard during playback.
