

*You may find in the box the line adaptor delivered separately from the line cable. In this case, you have to connect the line adaptor to the line cord first before plugging the line cord to the line socket. In multihandset packs, you will find one or more additional handsets, chargers with power supply units and additional rechargeable batteries.




I. Place the base station in a central location near the telephone line socket and electricity socket.

2. Place the base station face down so that you can see the bottom of the base station. Attach the base support to your base station by fitting the tabs of the base support into the corresponding slots on the base unit. Push into place until a click sound is heard.


3. Connect the line cord and the power cable to their corresponding connectors at the bottom of the base station as shown.

4. Connect the other end of the line cord to the telephone line socket and the other end of the power cable to the electricity socket.

Configure your phone (if necessary)

After charging your phone for a few minutes, a Welcome screen may appear depending on the country where you live. If the Welcome screen appears:

I. Scroll (a) to the word WELCOME in your preferred language and press C SELECT to confirm your selection.

2. Scroll (*) to your country and press SELECT to confirm your selection.

3. Press (a) to your operator (if necessary) and press SELECT again to confirm your selection. Set date and time

I. Press TMENU in idle mode, scroll (1) to Clock & Alarm and press TSELECT, press SELECT again to enter Set Date/Time.

2. Enter the current time (HH:MM) and current date (DD/MM/YY) and press \bigcirc OK.

A validation tone is emitted and your phone is now ready for use.



Make a call

Dial the number (maximum 24 digits) and press 🕹 key.

OR

Press <a>key to take the line and dial the number (maximum 24 digits).

Answer a call

When the phone rings, press \checkmark key.

End a call To end a conversation, press /= key.

Adjust earpiece volume During a call, press (\hat{e}) to select from Volume I to Volume 5.

Set the ring melody

- 1. Press MENU in idle mode, scroll () to Personal Set and press SELECT, press SELECT to enter Handset Tones, scroll (1) to Ring Melody and press SELECT.
- 2. Scroll $(\frac{1}{2})$ to your desired melody to play the melody.
- 3. Press **SELECT** to set the ring melody. A validation tone is emitted and the screen returns to previous menu.

Store a contact in the phonebook

- I. Press MENU in idle mode, scroll (1) to Phonebook and press SELECT, press SELECT to enter New Entry.
- 2. Enter the name of the contact (maximum 14 characters) and press COK.
- 3. Enter the phone number (maximum 24 digits) and press COK.
- 4. Scroll (a) to choose a group (<No Group>, <Group A>, <Group B>, <Group C>) and press SELECT.

A validation tone is emitted.

Access the phonebook

- I. Press $\stackrel{\square}{\bullet}$ in idle mode and scroll $\stackrel{(*)}{\bullet}$ to browse the phonebook.
- 2. To view the details of a phonebook entry, scroll $(\frac{1}{2})$ to the phonebook entry and press \Box VIEW.
- 3. To dial a number from the phonebook, scroll (1) to the phonebook entry and press \square .

Solution

- There's no dialling tone! Check the connections
 - Charge the batteries
 - Use the line cable provided
- Caller cannot hear me Move closer to the base station clearly!

 - Move the base station at least one metre away from any electrical appliances
- SEARCHING... is displayed Move closer to the base station blinking!
- on handset and 📗 icon is Make sure that your base station is correctly plugged
 - Reset your unit and restart handset registration
- Caller's number is not Check your subscription with your network operator
