# 2 Important

Please read and make sure you understand all instructions before using the TV. Damage caused by a failure to follow the instructions is not covered by the warranty.

## Safety

#### Risk of electric shock or fire!

- Never expose the TV to rain or water. Never place liquid containers (such as vases) next to the TV. If liquids are spilt on or inside the TV, disconnect the TV from the power supply immediately. Contact the Philips Customer Service Centre to have the TV checked before you use it again.
- Never place the TV, remote control or batteries near naked flames or other heat sources (including direct sunlight).

To avoid fire spreading, always keep candles or other naked flames away from the TV, remote control and batteries.



- Never insert any objects into the ventilation slots or other openings on the TV.
- Make sure that no strain is placed on the power cable when swivelling the TV. Strain on the power cable can loosen connections and cause arcing.
- The power plug of the TV must be disconnected to disconnect the TV from the mains supply. When you disconnect the power, always pull out the power plug, and never the cable. Ensure that the power plug, power cable and outlet socket are accessible at all times.

 The power plug is a disconnection device and should be kept so that it is easy to operate.

#### Risk of short circuit or fire!

#### **Stability Hazards!**

- Use a soft damp cloth to wipe the TV and frame. Never use substances such as alcohol, chemical products or household cleaners to clean the TV.

Note

- Watching programmes in 4:3 format for extended periods may leave different marks on the left and right of the screen and the border of the

- image. Therefore, avoid using this mode for prolonged periods.
- Displaying static images from video games and computers for extended periods may cause an afterimage and ghosting due to screen burn. Reduce the screen brightness and contrast accordingly when using the TV in this way.

Any afterimages, ghosting or marks displayed on the TV screen due to the causes mentioned above are not covered by the warranty.






#### (Recording)

## Remote control usage






# 4 Use your TV

## Switch the TV on or off





#### To switch on

- Plug in the power plug.
  - → If the standby indicator is lights up, press (¹) (Standby-On) on the remote control.


#### To switch to standby

- Press () (Standby-On) on the remote control.
  - → The standby indicator switches to light off.



 Though your TV consumes very little power when in standby mode, energy continues to be consumed. When not in use for an extended period of time, disconnect the TV power cable from the power outlet.


## Switch channels



- Press Channel control +/- on the remote control.
- Enter a channel number using the numeric buttons on the remote control.
- Press 
   on the remote control to switch and return to the previous channel.

#### View installed channel

All available channels can be viewed in the channel list.

- Press ▲▼ to select channels and to browse the channel list.





- Because the product is constantly updated, the software is upgraded at any time, if the software operation is different from the actual operation, please refer to the actual product.

## **Channel Settings**

Press ♠ to show the main menu, and press ◄/▶ to select CHANNEL.

## **Auto Tuning**

Press ▲/▼ to select Auto Tuning, then press OK to enter. press </br>
Tune Type: DTV+ATV / DTV / ATV.

Press ▼ , and press ▲/▼/﴿/▶ to select country, then press OK and the TV starts auto tuning.

During auto tuning, press 
 to exit it.

# ATV Manual Tuning (In ATV signal source)

Press ▲/▼ to select ATV Manual
Tuning, and press OK to enter. Press ▲/
▼ to select Sound System, Color
System, Current CH. Press ◀/▶ to adjust
these items. Select Search, press ◀/▶ to
search for low frequency or high
frequency. After searching, select FineTune and press ◀/▶ to tune for low
frequency or high frequency.

## **DTV Manual Tuning**

Press ▲/▼ to select DTV Manual Tuning, then press OK to enter. Press ◀/▶ to select channel, then press OK to search.

## **Programme Edit**

Press  $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$  to select Programme Edit, and press **OK** enter.

- Delete: Press red key on the remote control to delete the selected channel.

- Favorite: After choosing a channel, press yellow key — on the remote control to set your favorite channel.
   Press yellow key — again to cancel it.
- Skip: After selecting channel, press blue key — on the remote control to skip the channel. Press Blue key again to cancel it.

- Color Temperature: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ◄/▶ to select the color temperature mode.
- Aspect Ratio: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ▲/▼ to select the aspect ratio.
- Noise Reduction: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ▲/▼ to select the noise reduction mode.

## **Sound Settings**

Press ♠ to show the main menu, and press ◄/▶ to select SOUND. Press ▲/▼ to select the items.

- Sound Mode: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ◀/▶ to select the sound mode.
- Balance: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ◀/▶ to adjust the balance value of the sound.
- Surround Sound: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ▲/▼ to select to turn on/off the surround sound.
- SPDIF Output: Press OK to select Auto or PCM.
- AD Switch: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ◀/▶ to select to turn on/off the AD switch.

## Time Settings

Press  $\spadesuit$  to show the main menu, and press  $\blacktriangleleft/\triangleright$  to select TIME. Press  $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$  to select the items.

- Auto Sync: Press OK to select to turn on/off the auto sync.
- Clock: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ▲/▼/◀/▶ to set the time and date. (It is available when Auto Sync is Off)
- Off Time: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ▲/▼/◄/▶ to set the off time.
- On Time: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ▲/▼/◄/▶ to set the on time.
- Sleep Timer: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ▲/▼ to set the sleep time.
- Auto Sleep: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ▲/▼ to set the standby time.
- Time Zone: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ▲/▼/◀/▶ to set the time zone.

## **Option Settings**

Press ♠ to show the main menu, and press ◄/▶ to select **OPTION**, press ▲/▼ to select the items.

- OSD Language: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ▲/▼/◀/▶ to select the OSD language.

- **Subtitle**: Press **OK** to select to turn on/off the subtitle.

- **Hearing Impaired**: Press **OK** to select to turn on/off this function.
- Recorded List: Open the list of recorded programe.

- Restore Default: Press OK to enter Restore Default. ALL setup and channels will be reset.

## **PVR File System**

Press  $\spadesuit$ , and select OPTION > PVR File System, and press OK to enter, then press  $\spadesuit/\blacktriangledown$  to select the items.

- Select Disk: Press OK to enter and select a device for record files.
- Check PVR File System: Press OK to check the device information.
- Format: Press OK to format the USB device.
- Time Shift Size: Press OK to enter the submenu, then press ◀/▶ to select the disk capacity.
- Free Record Limit: Press ◀/▶ select the limit time of record file.

## **Lock Settings**

Press  $\spadesuit$  to show the main menu, and press  $\blacktriangleleft/\triangleright$  to select LOCK. Press  $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$  to select the items.

- Lock System: Press OK, then enter password 0000.
- Set Password: Set a new password for your TV.
- Block Program: Press Green key on the remote control to lock your program in the channel list.
- Parental Guidance: Adjust the program blocking level. This function helps parents block unsuitable channel according to the age of their child.



• Please enter "3448" in lock system, if you have forgotten your password.

## **FPG**

Press **TV GUIDE** to show the TV program guide list. (It is available in DTV Mode).

- Record: Press Red key on the remote control to record the program, then the recorder menu will show on TV. You can select channel and record mode, set the start time and end time; then press OK to confirm. Finished record program, the new task will appear in schedule list.
- Info: Press Green key on remote control to view the detailed information of the selected program.
- Schedule: Press Yellow key on remote control to view the list of scheduled recordings and reminders.
- Remind: Press Blue key on remote control to set a reminder for the selected program.

## **Recording Option**

In DTV mode, press • to show the Record option menu, and the TV system begins recording now.

Press ■ to stop and exit the recording.

Press ♠, and select OPTION > Recorded

List, then press OK to enter. Select the

file that you want to play, and press OK

to play it.



 This function is available only when the USB device is connected, and the USB in FAT32 format must be used. The duration of each recording should be no longer than 6 hours.

#### Recording options menu introduction.

- **I** FB30S: Play backward 30 seconds.

## **Time Shift Option**

In DTV mode, press II to show the Time Shift option menu, and the program is in pause status. Press to resume play program. Press ■ to stop and exit time shift function. When you pause a program for a short time, time shift function can pause and cache the playing program to U disk. When you resume playing, the program can continue to be played.

Select local disk device in the file directory and press OK to enter. Select Return in the directory, press OK to return to previous folder. Select the target folder and press OK to enter the folder. Then press  $\triangle/\nabla/\blacktriangleleft/\triangleright$  to select the target file and press  $\triangleright$  (play) to play it. Press **BACK** to return to the previous menu.

While playing, press **INFO** can display or hide toolbar. Select the menu option which you want, and press **OK** key to perform the operation. You can press **BACK** to exit playing, or press **■/II/◀**◀/▶/▶▶ on the remote control to perform shortcut operation.

# 7 Troubleshooting

This section covers common problems and their accompanying solutions.

## General issues

The TV cannot be switched on:

- Disconnect the power cable from the power outlet. Wait for one minute before reconnecting it.
- Check that the power cable is securely connected.

The remote control is not working properly:

- Check that the remote control batteries are correctly inserted according to the +/- orientation.
- Replace the remote control batteries if they are flat or weak.
- Clean the remote control and TV sensor lens.

The TV menu is in the wrong language.

Change the TV menu to your preferred language.

When turning the TV On/Off or to Standby, you hear a creaking sound from the TV chassis:

 No action is required. The creaking sound comes from the normal expansion and contraction of the TV as it cools down and warms up. This does not impact its performance.

## **Channel issues**

Previously installed channels do not appear in the channel list:

Check that the correct channel list is selected.

## Picture issues

The TV is on, but there is no picture:

- Check that the antenna is properly connected to the TV.
- Check that the correct device is selected as the TV source.

There is sound but no picture:

Check that the picture settings are correctly set.

Poor TV reception from the antenna connection:

- Check that the antenna is properly connected to the TV.
- Loudspeakers, unearthed audio devices, neon lights, high buildings and other large objects can influence reception quality. If possible, try to improve the reception quality by changing the antenna direction or moving devices away from the TV.
- If the reception on one particular channel is poor, please fine tune this channel.

There is poor picture quality from connected devices:

- Check that the devices are connected properly.
- Check that the picture settings are correctly set.

The picture does not fit the screen; it is too big or too small:

Try using a different picture format.

The picture position is incorrect:

 Picture signals from some devices may not fit the screen correctly.
 Please check the signal output of the device.

## Sound issues

The pictures are showing but sound quality is poor:



- If no audio signal is detected, the TV automatically switches the audio output off this does not indicate malfunction.
- Check that all cables are properly connected.
- Check that the volume is not set to 0.
- Check that the sound is not muted.
- Check that the sound settings are correctly set.

The pictures are showing but sound comes from one speaker only:

 Verify that sound balance is set to the centre.

## **HDMI** connection issues

There are problems with HDMI devices:

- Please note that HDCP (Highbandwidth Digital Content Protection) support can delay the time taken for a TV to display content from a HDMI device.
- If the TV does not recognise the HDMI device and no picture is displayed, please try switching the signal source to another device before switching it back again.
- If there are intermittent sound disruptions, please check that output settings from the HDMI device are correct.
- If you are using a HDMI to DVI adapter or cable, please check if the audio cable that comes with the product is connected to AUDIO (only for mini jacks).
