



Quick-Cross

Indications for Use

The Quick-Cross support catheters are guidewire exchange and infusion devices designed for use in the peripheral vasculature. The catheters are intended to support a guidewire during access of vasculature, allow for exchange of guidewires, and provide a conduit for the delivery of saline solutions or diagnostic contrast agents.

Contraindications

None known.

Potential Adverse Events

Vascular catheterization and/or vascular interventions may result in complications including but not limited to vessel dissection, perforation, or rupture, unstable angina; embolism; hypo/hypertension; acute myocardial infarction; arrhythmia, including ventricular fibrillation; infection; death.
