Indications for Use

Quick-Cross Select support catheters are intended to guide and support a guidewire during access of the peripheral vasculature, allow for wire exchanges and provide a conduit for the delivery of saline solutions or diagnostic contrast agents.

Contraindications

None known.

Potential Adverse Events

Vascular catheterization and/or vascular intervention may result in complications including but not limited to: vessel dissection, perforation, or rupture; infection; hematoma; unstable angina; embolism; hypo/hypertension; acute myocardial infarction; arrhythmia, including ventricular fibrillation; death.
