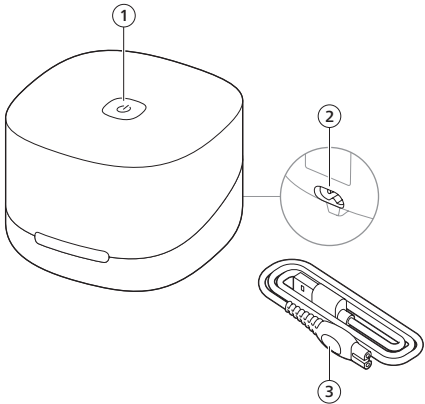

Cleaning the shaving unit with the UV Cube

- 1 Place the shaving unit in the Shaving UV Cube (Fig. 14).
- 2 Close the cover.
- 3 Press the on/off button to start the UV program (Fig. 15). The LED indicator will start flashing to indicate that the UV program is running (Fig. 16). The UV program takes 10 minutes.
- 4 When the UV program is finished, the LED indicator switches off. Open the Shaving UV Cube (Fig. 17) and let it ventilate.
- 5 Remove the shaving unit from the Shaving UV Cube.
- 6 Reattach the shaving unit to the shaver (Fig. 18).

Cleaning the Shaving UV Cube

- Clean the Shaving UV Cube after each use.
- 1 Remove the small plug from the Shaving UV Cube (Fig. 19).
 - 2 Clean the inside and outside of the Shaving UV Cube with a damp cloth (Fig. 20).

If you need support finding the correct USB supply unit, contact the Consumer Care Center in your country (see the international warranty leaflet for contact details). Using a non-certified supply unit may cause hazards or serious injuries.
- Keep the product, the USB cable and the USB supply unit dry (Fig. 2).
- This appliance is not washable. Never immerse the appliance in water and do not rinse it under the tap (Fig. 2).
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- The product is only suitable for Philips shaving units. Do not put any other objects in it.
- Do not use the supply unit in or near wall sockets that contain an electric air freshener to prevent irreparable damage to the supply unit.
- Do not use a damaged appliance. Replace damaged parts with new Philips parts.
- Never use compressed air, scouring pads, abrasive cleaning agents or aggressive liquids to clean the appliance.
- Stop using the product if the UV light remains on when the product is open.
- The UV light may cause eye and skin irritation. Do not expose eyes and skin to UV light.

General description (Fig. 1)

- 1 Power on/off button
- 2 Small plug socket
- 3 USB-A cable

Preparing for use

- 1 Insert the small plug of the USB cable into the socket on the rear side of the product (Fig. 4).
- 2 Insert the USB plug into the USB supply unit (not provided).
- 3 Insert the USB supply unit into the wall socket.

Cleaning the shaver with water

Make sure to clean your shaver after each shave.

While rinsing the shaving unit, water may drip out of the base of the shaver. This is a normal occurrence.

- 1 Switch on the shaver (Fig. 7).
- 2 Rinse the shaving unit with warm water (Fig. 8).
- 3 Switch off the shaver (Fig. 7). Press the release button to open the shaving unit (Fig. 9).
- 4 Rinse the hair chamber with warm water (Fig. 10).
- 5 Rinse the shaving head holder with warm water (Fig. 11).
- 6 Carefully shake off excess water and let the shaver dry for 12 hours for optimal results.
- 7 Close the shaving unit (Fig. 12).
- 8 Remove the shaving unit. Twist the shaving unit and then pull it off the product (Fig. 13).
